Steve is the CEO of CCHF, a nation-wide community of Christian health professionals committed to "living out the gospel through healthcare among the poor."



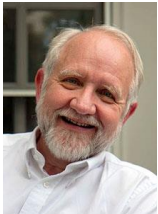
David Kim
