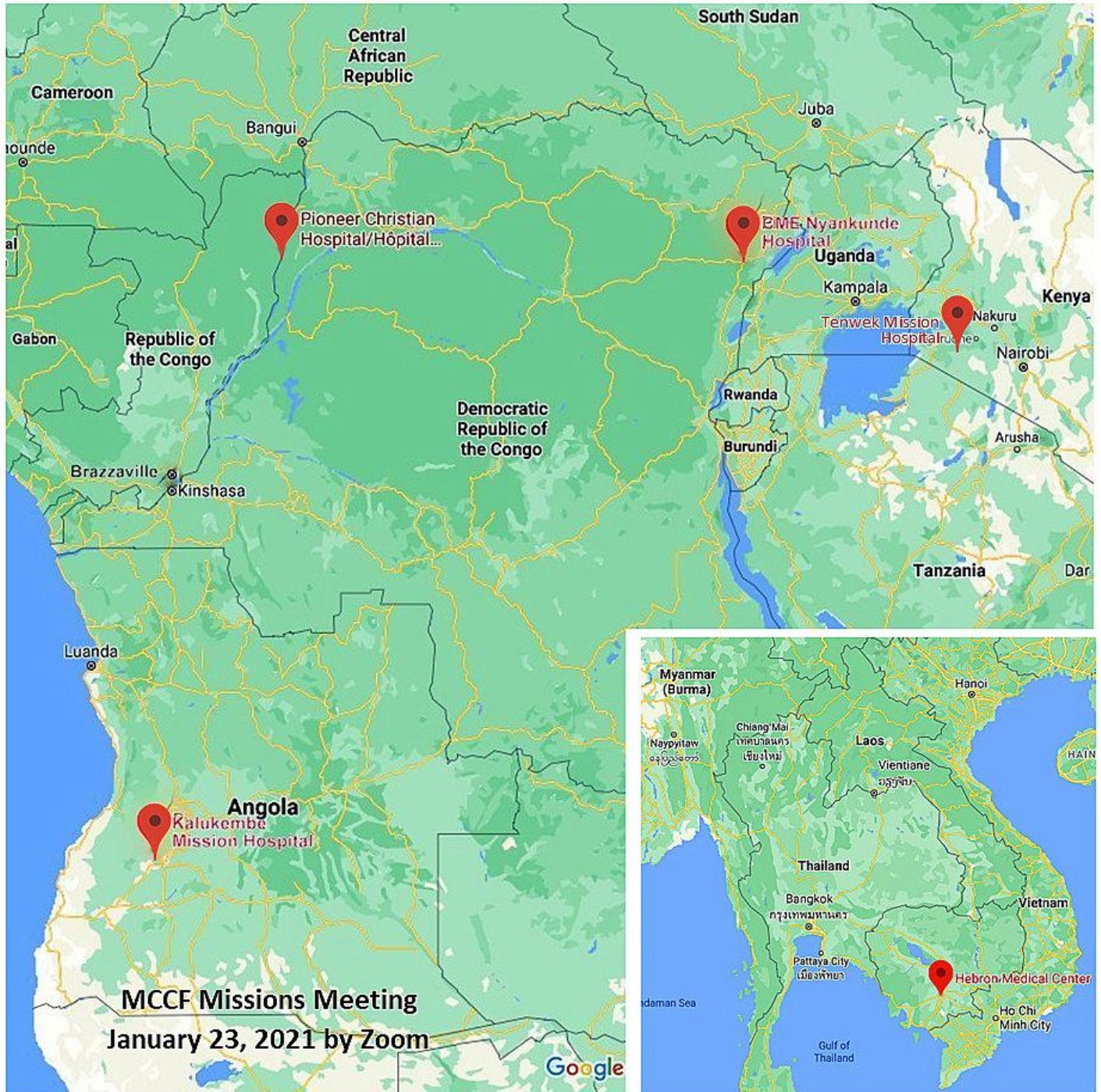


# MCCF Missions Zoom Meeting – January 23, 2021
